The Lean Launchpad platform, developed by serial entrepreneur professor Steve Blank, allows students to rapidly develop and test their ideas about a business model they have created around a real-world product. The course brings innovators to the students, then "flips" the classroom so students can learn through in-depth experience by teaching, conducting customer interviews, and working with the innovators to determine product-market fit and the business opportunity for a real-world technology spinoff.



Students build an initial business model & go-to-market strategy for a technology from one of our partners.



Teams iterate on their business models via feedback from 100+ total customer validation interviews. At the end of the semester, teams decide in a "go" or "no-go" discussion if their technology is viable for a spinoff company.


