### Courses

With a combination of accounting courses and the core business curriculum (including finance, economics, management, marketing, and ethics), our program will train you to be an effective accountant and ethical business leader.

#### Tax I (Individual Income Taxes)

Examines the concepts and methods of determining federal income tax liability for individuals. Topics emphasized include deductions, including Schedule C treatment for proprietor/LLC business income, capital gains and losses, and tax planning.

#### Tax II (Business Taxation)

Examines concepts and methods of determining federal, state, and international income tax liability for corporations, partnerships, estates, and trusts while examining tax strategy opportunities and emerging tax policies.

#### Accounting Analytics

Use industry-standard tools to extract, organize, and analyze large data sets to address accounting and other business questions. Emphasis is on recognizing and identifying appropriate tools for various types of data analysis, such as Excel, Alteryx, and Tableau (for data visualization).
